PUBLIC HEARING MEETING

The City of Hamilton held a public hearing on April 28, 2009 at 6:00 p.m. in the City Hall Auditorium for the purpose of discussing the city's submission of an application for the Fiscal Year 2009 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program. The purpose of the hearing was to discuss the town's submission of an application for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program. The town is very interested in obtaining all citizens' input on community development needs within the town. As part of the hearing process citizens were asked to verbally assist in the completion of a Needs Assessment document. Information presented included the amount of grant funds available, the range of eligible activities that may be undertaken and a discussion of the proposed project for which the City intends to submit an application to the State of Alabama requesting Community Development Block Grant funds. All citizens were urged to express their views on the town's most pressing housing and community development needs. The town is proposing to make an application for CDBG funding to develop a downtown revitalization plan.
