A regular meeting of the Mayor and City Council of Hamilton, Alabama was held on June 1, 2009 at 6:00 p.m. in the Auditorium of Hamilton City Hall. The first order of business was a motion by McDavid Franks that the minutes from the last meeting be approved. April Steele seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

Annette Sherrill made a motion to approve the Accounts Payable Bills pending review from the City Council. Paul Stidham seconded the motion. All voted "Yes".

McDavid Franks made a motion to approve Resolution number 2009-6-1 authorizing and approving an application for the State of Alabama's (ADECA) CDBG-R Program.

RESOLUTION 2009-6-1  
AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING APPLICATION

FOR THE STATE OF ALABAMA'S (ADECA) CDBG-R Program

WHEREAS, the City of Hamilton is applying for CDBG-R funding through the State of Alabama's Community Development Block Grant Program,

WHEREAS, the City of Hamilton concurs with objectives, needs and program activities proposed therein, and

WHEREAS, priorities for proposed program activities adopted by the City of Hamilton were determined in accordance with State and Federal guidelines and determinations on eligibility of activities,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF HAMILTON:

1. That said application shall be designated as the official application for the City of Hamilton to be submitted to the Alabama Department of Economic and Community Affairs upon its completion.
2. That the Mayor is duly authorized to sign said application for and act on behalf of the City of Hamilton and is further authorized to execute all other documents required for application or disbursement of State of Alabama Community Development Block Grant funds for the City of Hamilton.

#### ORDINANCE 2009-6

#### AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HAMILTON TO AMEND ORDINANCE NUMBER 2009-4 OF THE CITY OF HAMILTON FINES FOR CERTAIN PARKING VIOLATIONS IN THE POLICE JURISDICTION AND CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF HAMILTON

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Hamilton, Alabama as follows:

#### SECTION I. AMENDMENT.

That Section 3, entitled "Minimum Fines for parking violations as follows", of Ordinance 2009-4 of the City of Hamilton be and hereby is amended to include the following:

#### SECTION 3. Minimum Fines for parking violation as follows:

2. Improper Parking:  
\$25.00
4. Parking in Prohibited Zone:  
\$25.00
8. Improper Parking in Parking Lot  
\$25.00

Other than as provided above, all other fines in Section 3 of Ordinance 2009-4 of the City of Hamilton is adopted, realleged and incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein.

SECTION II. INCLUSION. Other than as provided in Section 1 of this amendment, Ordinance 2009-4 of the City of Hamilton is adopted, realleged and incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein.

SECTION III. SEVERABILITY. Each and every provision of this ordinance is hereby declared to be an independent provision, and the holding of any provision hereof to be void or invalid, shall not affect any other provision hereof, and it is hereby declared that the other provisions of this ordinance would have been enacted regardless of any provision which might be held invalid.

SECTION IV. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall become effective on June 1, 2009.

He also reminded everyone of the Public Hearing on June 15<sup>th</sup>, 2009 at 5:30 p.m. at the Hamilton City Hall Auditorium to discuss the adoption of a uniform building code.

There being no further business, April Steele made a motion that the meeting be adjourned. Annette Sherrill seconded the motion, following a unanimous consent in favor Mayor Holliday declared the meeting adjourned.
