

MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF
THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF HAMILTON, ALABAMA

August 17, 2009

A regular meeting of the Mayor and City Council of Hamilton, Alabama was held on August 17, 2009 at 6:00 p.m. in the Auditorium of Hamilton City Hall. Mayor Pro-Tem Annette Sherrill called the meeting to order and welcomed all guests. Scotty Sanderson led the Pledge of Allegiance and Bill Tyra gave the invocation. Those present were:

The first order of business was a motion by Scotty Sanderson that the Minutes from the last meeting be approved. April Steele seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

The next item on the agenda was a motion made by April Steele to hire Charles Scott as a temporary police officer at an hourly rate of pay of \$12.75. Paul Stidham seconded the motion and all voted "Yes".

At this time Mayor Pro-Tem Annette Sherrill stated that the City Council had previously voted at the last City Council Meeting to hire a Street Department Employee and she further recommended to the Council the hiring of an additional employee. McDavid Franks made a motion to hire Tommy Miller and Jason Nelson as garbage collectors for the Street Department at an hourly rate of pay of \$11.40. Paul Stidham seconded the motion and all voted in favor.

Mayor Pro-Tem Annette Sherrill also stated that the City Council had previously voted at the last City Council Meeting to hire a police officer and she further recommended to the Council the hiring of an additional police officer. April Steele made a motion to approve hiring an additional police officer and McDavid Franks seconded the motion. Voting was as follows: Ayes: McDavid Franks, Scotty Sanderson, Annette Sherrill, April Steele and Paul Stidham. Nays: None.

At this time Mayor Pro-Tem Annette Sherrill made the following announcements:

1. The City of Hamilton will have a Special Called Meeting on Thursday, August 20th, 2009 at 5:00 p.m. for the purpose of hiring two police officers.
2. The City of Hamilton Planning Commission will meet Thursday, August 20th, 2009 at 6:00 p.m. at Hamilton City Hall.
3. Fulton Bridge Industrial Park lighting project is underway.

McDavid Franks encouraged citizens to please remove their old yard sale signs. Scotty Sanderson announced that soccer is up coming and if you are interested in playing to please contact Larry Armstrong at the recreation center. He also stated he had received several complaints regarding road blocks for donations in the city and would like to discuss the matter at the next work session.

Mayor Pro-Tem Sherrill asked for comments from the public. Mrs. Tami Williams came forward and gave the Council a list of complaints regarding the Marion County Animal Shelter.

There being no further business, Scotty Sanderson made a motion that the meeting be adjourned. April Steele seconded the motion, following a unanimous consent in favor Mayor Pro-Tem Sherrill declared the meeting adjourned.
