

MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF
THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF HAMILTON, ALABAMA

September 8, 2009

A regular meeting of the Mayor and City Council of Hamilton, Alabama was held on September 8, 2009 at 6:00 p.m. in the Auditorium of Hamilton City Hall. Mayor Holliday called the meeting to order and welcomed all guests. McDavid Franks led the Pledge of Allegiance and James Tate gave the invocation. Those present were:
