

MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF  
THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF HAMILTON, ALABAMA

December 12, 2008

Proper notice having been given, a Special Meeting of the Mayor and City Council of the City of Hamilton, Alabama was held on Friday, December 12, 2008 at 9:00 a.m. in the mayor's office. Those present were:

Mayor Holliday called the meeting to order and welcomed all guests.

Mayor Holliday stated the purpose of the meeting was to vote to hire three police officers two to fill vacancies caused by resignations, and one needed due to shortage in staffing.

At this time Scotty Sanderson made a motion to accept the resignations of police officers Tracy Raper effective December 16, 2008 and Gena Rushing effective December 18, 2008. Paul Stidham seconded the motion which passed without opposition.

At approximately 9:10 a.m. Scotty Sanderson made a motion to enter into executive session to discuss good name and character. McDavid Franks seconded the motion. All voted "Yes".

At approximately 9:25 a.m. Scotty Sanderson made a motion to return to regular session. McDavid Franks seconded the motion. All voted in favor.

A recommendation was then made to hire the following police officers with effective hire date December 12, 2008:

- Scotty Chandler at 13.75 per hour.
- Lance Stidham at 11.75 per hour, after graduation from police academy 12.75 per hour, and end of probation period 13.75 per hour.
- Kenneth Holcomb at 11.75 per hour, after graduation from police academy 12.75 per hour, and end of probation period 13.75 per hour.

McDavid Franks then motioned to approve the above mentioned recommendation. Scotty Sanderson seconded the motion and voting was as follows: Ayes: McDavid Franks, Scotty Sanderson, April Steele. Abstained: Paul Stidham Nays: None.

There being no further business for this Special Session, Scotty Sanderson motioned that the meeting be adjourned. April Steele seconded the motion which passed unanimously.
