

MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF
THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF

February 19, 2010

Proper notice having been given, a Special Meeting of the Mayor and City Council was held on Friday, February 19, 2010 at 4:00 p.m. in the Auditorium of Hamilton City Hall. Those present were:

Mayor Holliday called the meeting to order and welcomed all guests. At this time Mayor Holliday recommended to enter into executive session to discuss the general reputation and character, physical condition, professional competence or mental health of individuals and to discuss the job performance of certain public employees and to consider the discipline or dismissal of public employees.

Scotty Sanderson made a motion to enter in executive for the reasons given above. McDavid Franks seconded the motion and voting was as follows: Ayes: McDavid Franks, Scotty Sanderson, Annette Sherrill, April Steele and Paul Stidham. Nays: None.

At approximately 5:13 p.m. McDavid Franks motioned to return to regular session and Scotty Sanderson seconded the motion. All voted in favor.

McDavid Franks made a motion to terminate Chief of Police Teena Fields. Annette Sherrill seconded the motion and all voted "Yes".

Scotty Sanderson made a motion to suspend Chief Investigator Phillip King for ten days without pay pending further investigation. Paul Stidham seconded the motion and voting was as follows: Ayes: Scotty Sanderson, April Steele and Paul Stidham. Nays: McDavid Franks and Annette Sherrill. Motion carried by majority vote.

Annette Sherrill made a motion that the meeting be adjourned. Scotty Sanderson seconded the motion, following a unanimous consent in favor Mayor Holliday declared the meeting adjourned.
