WHEREAS, the Special Wet/Dry Referendum for the City of Hamilton, Alabama was duly and legally held on March 23rd, 2010, as provided by law, and

WHEREAS, the said municipal governing body of that City of Hamilton met on this 24th day of March, 2010, a quorum thereof being present, at 12:00 p.m., and has canvassed the returns, and has ascertained and determined the number of votes received by each "Yes" and "No", and

WHEREAS, the said municipal governing body as ascertained and determined the results of said referendum as follows:

“No” 1262

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF HAMILTON, ALABAMA as follows:

That the “no” votes received the majority of the ballots casts in the wet/dry determination. Therefore, the City of Hamilton remains dry.
